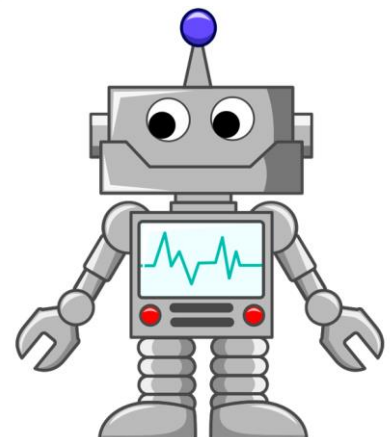
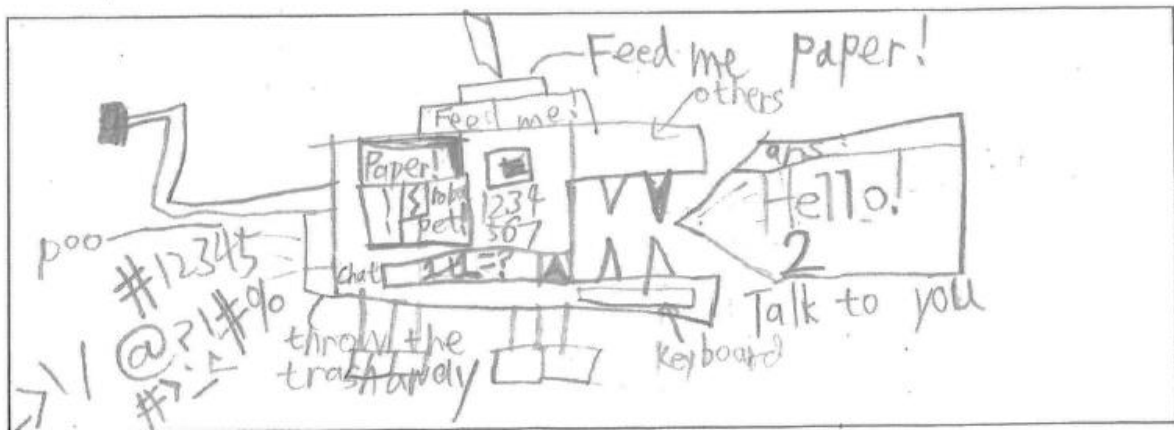

To Fly in a spaceship

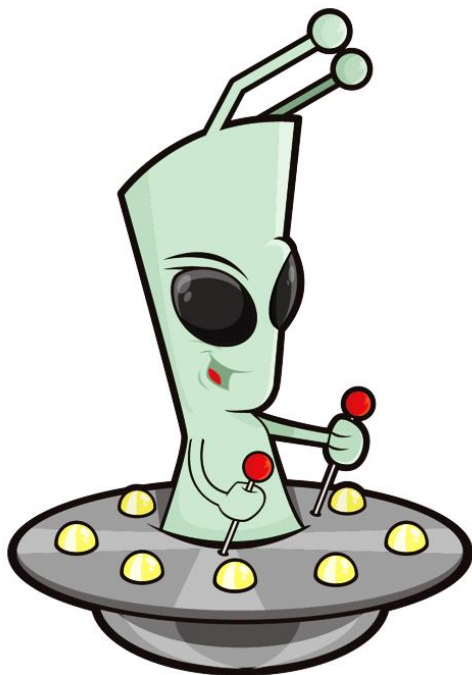
